#### **ITINERARY**

#### DAY 1

#### HOME CITIES TO LETHBRIDGE, AB

Your journey begins this morning as we depart Regina and continue west to pick up passengers in Moose Jaw.

As we travel across the open prairie landscape, enjoy wide skies, farmland views, and the peaceful rhythm of the rolling highway.

We stop in Swift Current for a quick coffee break, then continue into Alberta for lunch in Medicine Hat.

We will make a fun photo stop one of Southern Alberta's most iconic roadside attractions.

We arrive at our hotel in Lethbridge, where a Welcome Reception awaits to kick off our tour in style.

#### DAY 2

#### WATERTON LAKES NATIONAL PARK

This morning we travel south toward the spectacular scenery of Waterton Lakes National Park, where the Rocky Mountains rise dramatically from the prairie.

Upon arrival, we board the Waterton Shoreline Cruise, a 2.5-hour scenic boat tour. The cruise includes a stop at Goat Haunt Landing Ranger Station, giving you a chance to explore this remote, historic outpost along the U.S.-Canada border while taking in stunning mountain and lakeside scenery. Enjoy mountain views, crystal-clear waters, and fascinating stories about the region's natural and cultural history.

Following the cruise, enjoy lunch and free time in Waterton Village. Wander the lakeshore, browse local shops, or relax at one of the cafés.

We will return to Lethbridge early evening.

## DAY 3 FORT MACLEOD

Today we explore some of Southern Alberta's most meaningful historic sites.

We begin in Fort Macleod with a visit to The Fort Museum, where exhibits bring the early days of the North-West Mounted Police to life. Here we will also enjoy the NWMP Musical Ride, a 20-minute performance showcasing the precision, horsemanship, and tradition of Canada's original mounted police force.

We will have lunch in Fort Macleod before travelling to the UNESCO World Heritage Site Head-Smashed-In Buffalo Jump. Learn how Indigenous Peoples skillfully used the land to conduct buffalo hunts for thousands of years. The interpretive centre, trails, and cliff views make this an unforgettable stop.

We return to Lethbridge late afternoon for a relaxing evening.

## DAY 4 LETHBRIDGE, AB TO HOME CITIES

After loading luggage on the bus, we begin our journey home from Lethbridge.

Our first stop is the impressive Saamis Teepee in Medicine Hat, an iconic landmark perfect for photos and a quick stretch.

Following this, enjoy lunch in Medicine Hat, with plenty of time to relax and do some shopping.

After lunch, we will make our way back to our home cities with new friendships formed and memories to last a lifetime.
